Option 1: Show Horse – For the equine athlete that travels to shows, 4-H events, clinics and/or other populated areas where horses from many locations meet.

Option 2: Pleasure Horse – For the horse that goes on occasional trail rides, to local events, and/or is kept at a boarding facility.

Option 3: Senior Horse – For the older horse (~20+) kept at a boarding facility, in an open herd, and/or who is still relatively active.

Option 4: Companion Horse – For the horse who lives in a closed herd and/or at home and is not taken to any public facilities or events.

Conditions of Enrollment

1. Payment for the Wellness Program is required in full at the time of enrollment.
2. Clients with account balances must be paid in full prior to enrollment in the program unless otherwise arranged with the office.
3. Farm calls are not included in the price of the Wellness Program. Farm call fees are determined by location and number of clients to be seen. Clinic appointments are always available as well.
4. Tacoma Equine Hospital will attempt to contact you when your horse needs a visit. However, clients are responsible for setting up appointments for Wellness Program services.
5. Total annual cost does not reflect any additional charges incurred for treatments, exams or dental work not indicated in the individual Wellness Programs. Boosters for initial vaccines on unvaccinated horses are not included in the program and are charged separately and require a separate visit. All program components are recommended, however if you choose to not have the doctor administer a specific procedure, you will not receive a refund for the cost of the procedure.
6. Substitutions only available upon recommendation and approval by the office manager and/or veterinarian.
7. Renewal for the program will be on the anniversary date of initial enrollment. If you do not utilize all of the services in your selected program within a year of enrollment, there will be no refund or substitutions for the unused procedures.
8. If a horse is sold while enrolled in one of the Wellness Programs, you may transfer any unused portion of the program with the horse or to another horse that you own. If a horse dies while enrolled in one of the Wellness Programs, you may transfer the plan to another horse that you own. No refunds will be given for unused portions of the plan.
